- 1. Call to order: Vanguard Electric Commission President Peter Huebner called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.
- 2. Roll call: Those in attendance upon roll call were Rod Howard, Mitch Hodson, Kyle Kepler, Peter Huebner, and Mike Krawczyk. There was a quorum.
- **3. Proof of posting:** A copy of the notice was posted July 17, 2020 to the Village of Mazomanie and the Village of Black Earth. It was also transmitted to Star News.
- 4. Approval of minutes dated May 19, 2020: Motion by Hodson/Kepler to approve May minutes. Motion passed.
- **5. Financial report:** Slowly applying Cardinal down payment as expenses accrue. YTD net income \$30K compared to \$27K at this time last year. \$800 of June net income was a League Insurance dividend. \$2000 chipper repair and minor repair in Truck 4 (pickup) last month.
 - **a. Review of books for Q3/Q4 2019:** Zak Bloom completed his review of the books. A few minor items for Lydia to fix, including adjusting numbering of A/P checks, closing work orders, zeroing out immaterial balances in payroll liability accounts, and updating Prepaid Health Insurance account balance. AC Engineering is here commissioning breakers this week. Blink in Mazo last Friday was due to an Alliant PT that went bad and blinked the ATC transmission line. Storm last week caused no outages in BE, but several calls in Mazo. Guys also went to Sauk that night for mutual aid help. In BE, overhead to underground conversion along Fesenfeld Rd is almost done. This line has historically caused many outages. Lots of temp services for new houses.
